The ReStore collects new and used (tax-deductible) building materials, furniture and appliances from residential and commercial donors.

All ReStore proceeds support the building of new and rehabilitated houses in our community. Donation Criteria

Appliances

Must be 5 years old or newer, with all parts, in good working order

Dish Washers
Gas and Electric Ovens
Range Hoods
Range tops
Refrigerators
Washers/Dryers

Architectural Items

Antique items
Columns
Mantels
Porch posts

Cabinetry

In good condition with intact doors and drawers
Full kitchen and bathroom sets
Individual pieces
Counter tops with straight sections, no holes
Hardware

Doors

Residential only
Entryway units
Exterior or interior, - *no rot, cracks or missing panes*
Pre-hung or slab doors - *no taller than 84"*

Flooring

Hardwood/Parquet flooring—*25 sq. ft. or more*
New carpet 10'x10' or larger
New padding
New vinyl tiles or vinyl sheets
Slate/Marble and ceramic tiles

Furniture

Good condition and structurally sound, no pet stains, rips, tears, missing parts
Case goods, book shelves
Hardwood tables & chairs

Hardware

Keep Separated; must be free of rust
Complete sets of door hardware
Any quantity of hinges, nails, screws, hangers, etc.

Lighting

Good to excellent condition, complete and in working order

No fluorescent or can lights

Lumber and Sheetrock

Dimensional, 6' or longer
Trim & Molding, 5' or longer
Sheetrock & Plywood, 4'x4' or larger
No scrap lumber, no nails, no concrete on wood

Miscellaneous

Free-standing wood stoves
Garden tools *in working order*
Hand Tools & Power Tools *in working order*
HVAC units, - *5 yrs old or newer*
Shutters
Water Heaters - *5 years old or newer*

Paint & Wall Coverings

Latex Paint Only, *full, unopened and non-rusted*
Wallpaper, borders tools & glue - *full rolls only*

Plumbing

Bathubs, fiberglass, claw-foot, steel, - *space permitting*
Faucets - *complete sets only*
Sinks - kitchen & bath - *without rust or cracks*
Shower enclosures - *no cracks or stains*
Toilets - *residential only, must be clean!*
Miscellaneous plumbing hardware, fittings, pipes, etc.

Windows

Double Hung, Picture, Bay - *complete, without rot, cracks, or foggy glass. No sashes, single-pane or storm windows*

Not Accepted at the ReStore

<i>No commercial items</i>	<i>Regulated fluids</i>
<i>Anti-freeze or motor oil</i>	<i>Sashes or Storm windows</i>
<i>Can lights</i>	<i>Shower Doors</i>
<i>Fireplace inserts</i>	<i>Solvents or Strippers</i>

<i>Hard-wired fluorescent lights</i>	
<i>Hazardous materials</i>	
<i>Lumber under 6'</i>	
<i>Molded, rotted or soiled materials</i>	
<i>Open cans of paint/varnish</i>
